	<p>FLUORINATED WAX BAN & FLUOR WAX TESTING UPDATE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> As previously communicated on 22nd March, a fluor wax ban will be fully implemented at the start of the upcoming 2023-2024 winter season. FIS is committed to banning fluor products used in ski preparation given the health risks and environmental concerns connected to fluorine waxes and stands fully behind the testing procedure in place for the upcoming season. In order to have a testing process that runs smoothly at the beginning of the season and to eliminate any speculation of a possible contamination of skis/snowboards, the FIS Council

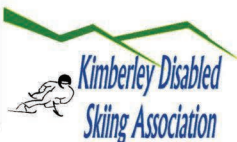

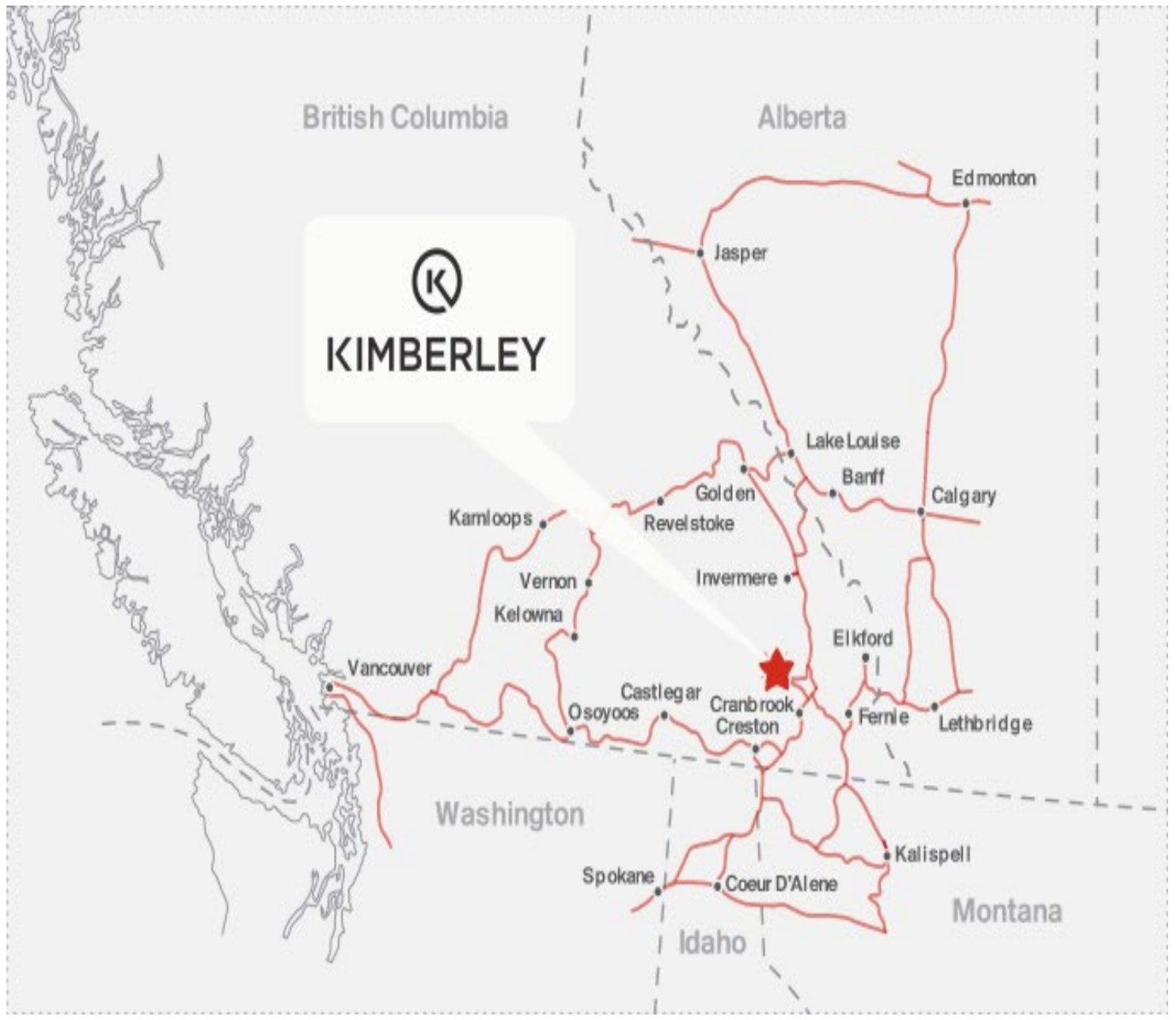

5.1 Canadian Athletes - FIS Masters Criterium Information.

ALL Canadian, age eligible athletes seeking to participate in the FIS Masters Criterium in Kimberley, BC MUST be members in good standing with a Canadian club; and have purchased their 2023/2024 memberships including FIS licenses by February 2024.

FIS Master's licensed athletes can then seek entry submission to the event, through their club / PTSO. Entries are a formal process and CANNOT be done individually, or direct with the local organizers. Race entry deadlines are in effect, please reference the race notice for dates.
